
- 7 Arrange transport to your accommodation

Make appointment with the <u>Dutch Immigration and Naturalisation</u> Service (IND) to pick up your residence document.

Please note that the Central Student Administration (CSA) will let you know you when your document is ready to be picked up. Instructions by e-mail.

10 Pick up Residence document in person from the IND



Make an appointment online or by telephone. You can also try just going along to the municipal office without an appointment. Can take a long time, but usually works out.

- → Take the following information/documents
 - 1. Address of your accommodation, 2. Passport/Proof of identity 3. Residence document, 4. Birth certificate,
 - 5. Rental agreement or letter of permission from occupant 6. Proof of admission (received from the study programme)

Make appointment by telephone: +31 (0) 20 - 777 8899 ask for: Maaike Bakker (location Dam Square) of Kimberly Willemse (location Van Bearlestraat)

- → Take the following information/documents
 - 1. Proof of admission, 2. Passport/Proof of identity, 3. Residence document,
 - 4. Your Citizen Service Number (BSN) issued by municipality.
 - (Please note that it can take up to a month to get an appointment with the municipality.)
- 13 Apply online for Digi-D → digid.nl

Once you have been to the municipality and you have your BSN. With this number you get access to governmental websites.
