



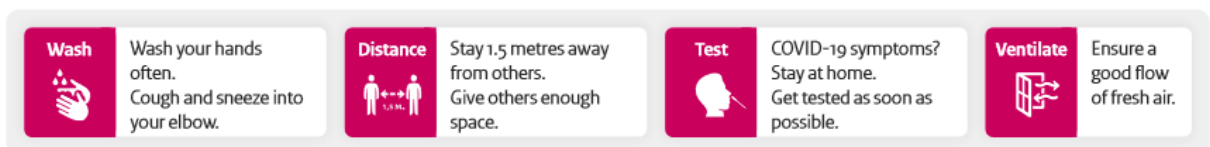
## AHK Coronavirus Measures Protocol (as of 30 August 2021)

From 30 August, 2021, the corona measures for higher education have been partially relaxed, so that more physical education is possible. The AHK follows the remaining guidelines of the National Institute for Public Health and the Environment (RIVM) and the central government in order to minimize the risk of coronavirus infections among students and employees as much as possible. In order to achieve that, it is of the utmost importance that employees, teachers and students are alert and comply with the guidelines below.

- Only come to work or school if you do not have any symptoms.
- You should only come to the location, if you do not have any symptoms, within the timetable drawn up/timeslot designated by the academy and/or as agreed with the supervisor.
- Follow all instructions within the buildings.
- It is compulsory to wear a face mask within the communal areas of the buildings, such as entrances, hallways, corridors and sanitary facilities. You can take off your face mask once you are at a fixed seat in a classroom, your workplace or the designated spots in the canteens.
- Do a corona self-test twice a week. You can order self-tests for free via [www.zelftestonderwijs.nl](http://www.zelftestonderwijs.nl) (log in with your AHK account).
- If you have (mild) coronavirus-like symptoms <sup>1</sup>, please get yourself tested for the coronavirus by the Municipal Health Service (GGD) immediately. This is possible without a referral from the company doctor or GP. <https://www.rijksoverheid.nl/onderwerpen/coronavirus-covid-19/testen/afspraken-maken>
- Stay home until you receive the result of the test.
- In the event of a positive test, you will stay at home, of course, in line with the advice of the GGD. Inform those you have been in close contact with about your infection.
- You should also stay at home if a housemate has symptoms and the test result is still unknown, or if you have been in (close) contact with someone who has tested positive.
- If you are approached during contact tracing, follow the advice of the GGD immediately.
- In all cases, comply with the quarantine recommended or imposed by the GGD, RIVM or central government and do not come to work or school during that period.
- Students who expect to suffer a study completion delay as a result of the quarantine / isolation imposed by the GGD should contact the study adviser / student counsellor as soon as possible.

In the event of a positive test result, please inform the academy immediately and in this way help to prevent (part of) the institution from having to be closed by the AHK board or the government, because the proper measures could not be taken in time. <sup>1</sup> Symptoms that may point to coronavirus infection include a nasal cold, runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, coughing, sudden loss of smell or taste, elevated temperature, fever and shortness of breath.
